The Territory Battery is a stand-alone battery facility with up to 300 MW / 600 MWh energy storage capacity. It is being proposed by Neoen at a site adjacent to the existing Stockdill Substation, near Belconnen, ACT. The project recently obtained conditional approval from the government planning and land authority and is in advanced stages of development.

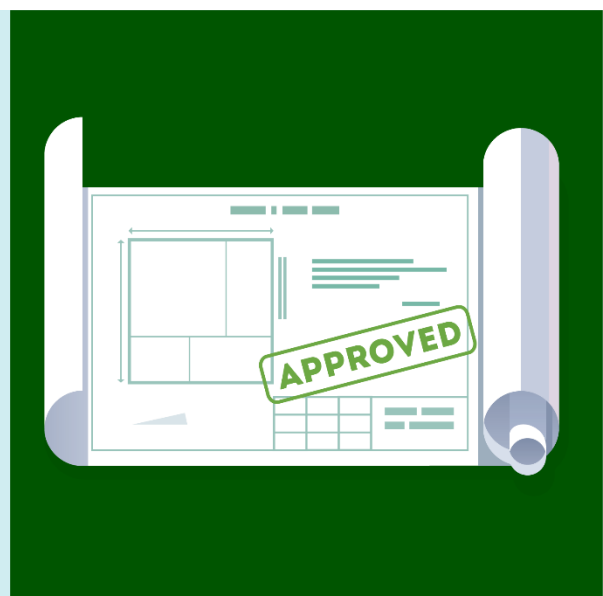
Development Approval

In 2024, Territory Battery received no action on its Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) from the Acting Minister for Planning. Following this, we submitted a development application for this renewable energy project to ACT Government's Environment, Planning and Sustainable Development (EPSD) team in October 2024.

This application was made in accordance with the state government's requirements and included several layout plans, the EIS, management plans and survey certificates. You are welcome to view these plans [here](#).

The EPSD team, pursuant to Section 162 of the Planning and Development Act 2007, has approved the development of Territory Battery. This is subject to a range of conditions which is available publicly for anyone in the community to review using the link shared above.

Neoen will continue to work and develop the project and ensure that all pre-construction conditions of our application are met before we progress to the next stage.
